Nursery class be removed from the premises of the school, if any. And no Branch of this school shall be run under the banner of the recognised school.
10. That the school shall dispense with the services of unqualified and overaged staff, if any, immediately.
11. That the scheme of management shall be got approved from the Department immediately.
12. That service contract between the management and the employees shall be executed immediately.
13. That all the facilities proscribed under Rules 50 & 51 of the DSER, 1973 shall be made available to the students. Provision of Rules 6, 7 and 9 be strictly observed.
14. That the arrangements for good drinking water shall be made available to all the students as well as to teachers and sanitary facilities shall also be provided to the students adequately. Health Certificate may be obtained from the local body within a month.



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
