Colours of Culture, Dreams of Tomorrow

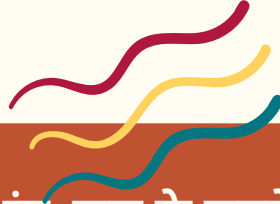

The day concluded on a joyful note, reminding everyone that sports teach us teamwork, confidence, discipline, and the spirit to keep trying.

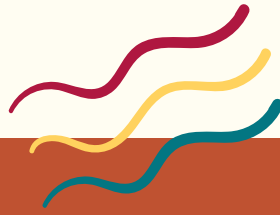

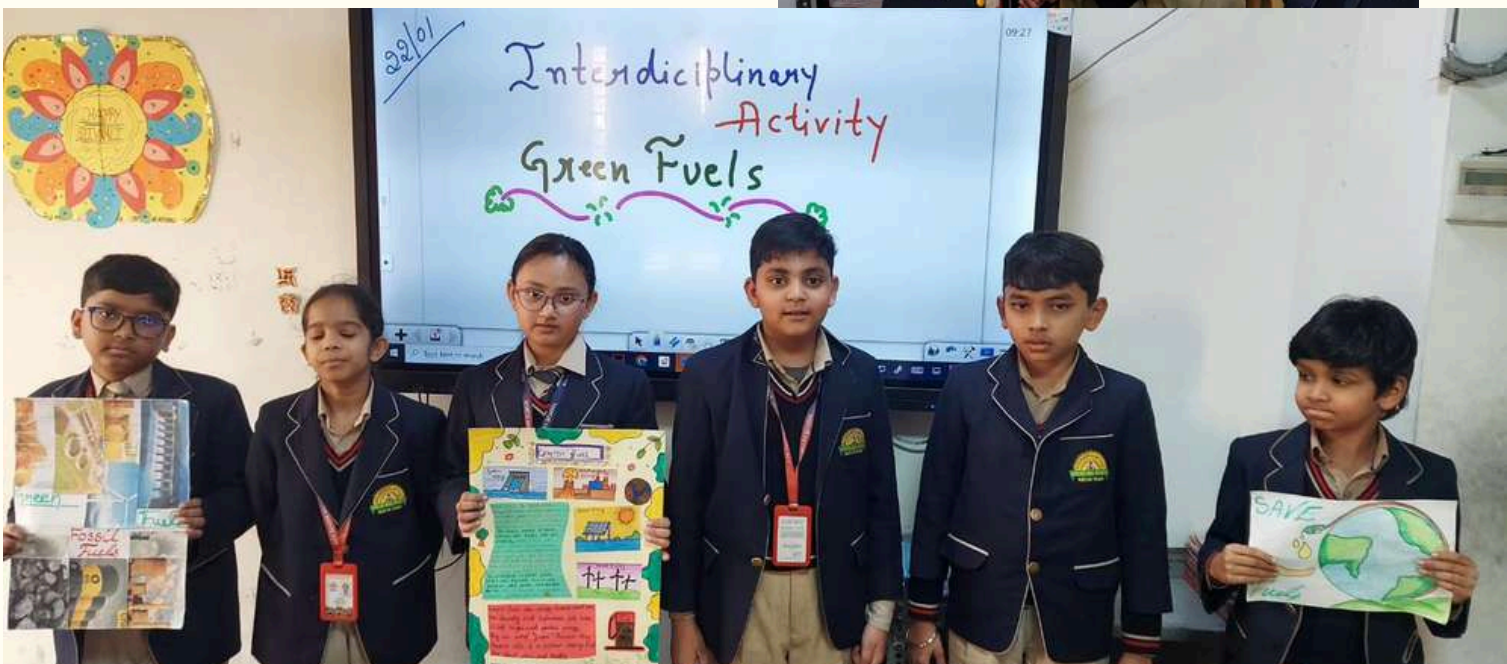
Newspaper Designing

- Celebrating Diversity: Many Cultures, One World

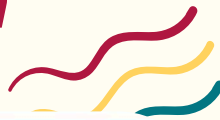

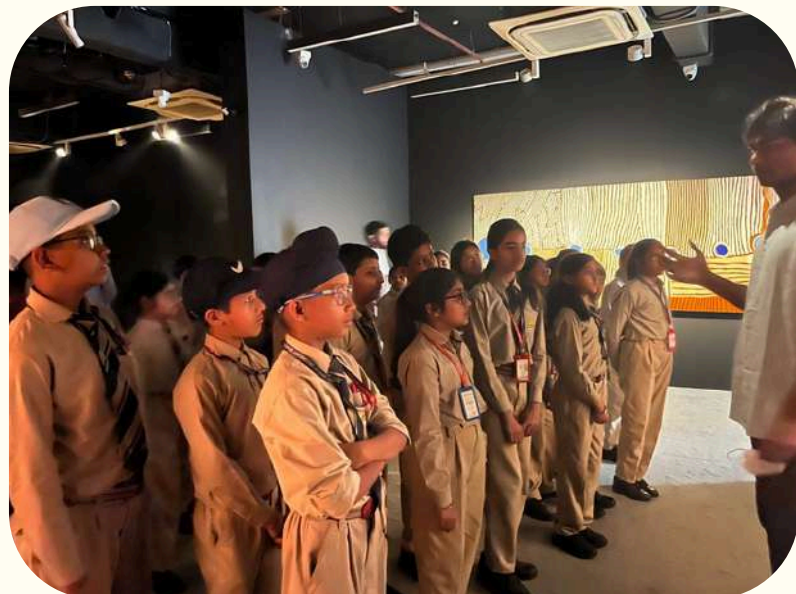
Exhibition at Humayun's Tomb
