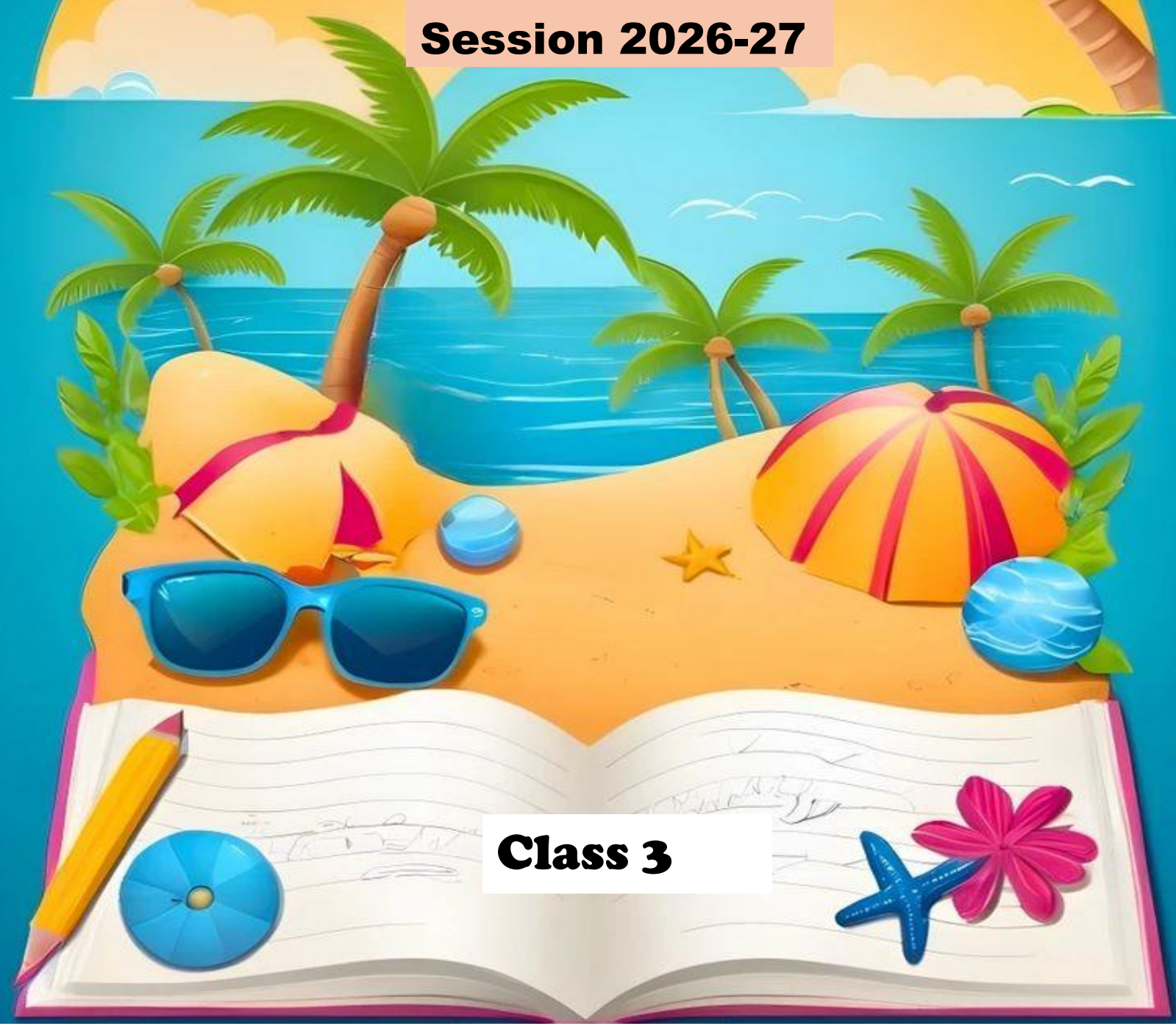

What to Include in Your Script-

Your puppet should say:

- Who are you?
(Hello! I am a farmer...)
- What do you do?
(I grow crops and take care of plants...)
- Why is your work important?
(I help people get food...)
- How do you feel about your work
(I feel proud and happy...)

Writing Guidelines

- Use simple and short sentences
- Begin with a greeting
- Write neatly and give a nice border to your sheet
- Use colours and drawings
- Add voice and expressions
- Make it fun and lively!

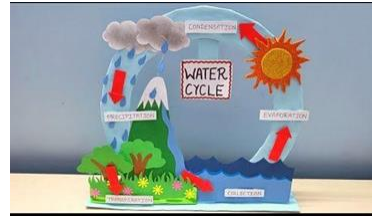
A. Upcycled Plastic Suncatchers (Roll no. 1 to 20)
