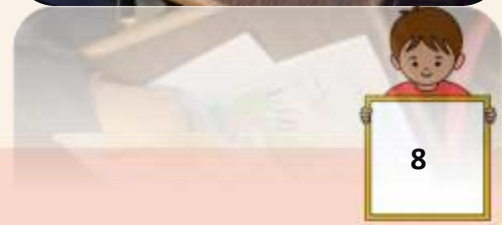
The event underscored the belief that even the youngest voices can contribute meaningfully to the global conversation on environmental stewardship.
