They explored the life cycle of plants, understood the importance of care and responsibility, and developed a meaningful connection with nature. The activity not only strengthened their scientific observation skills but also nurtured values that will stay with them for years to come.

Students of Classes 1 and 2 got a deliciously fun experience in the hands-on activity Master Cook - Chef for a Day, where they engaged in flameless cooking. 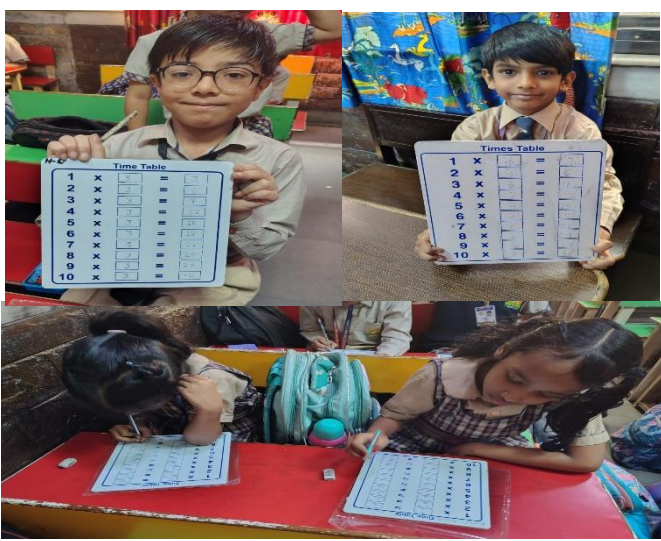

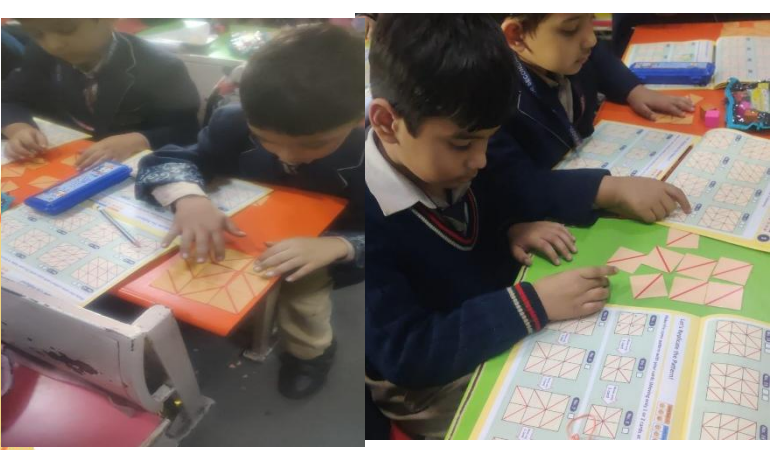

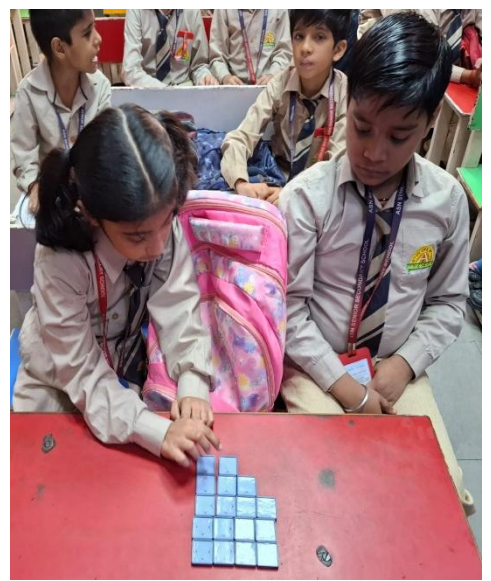
