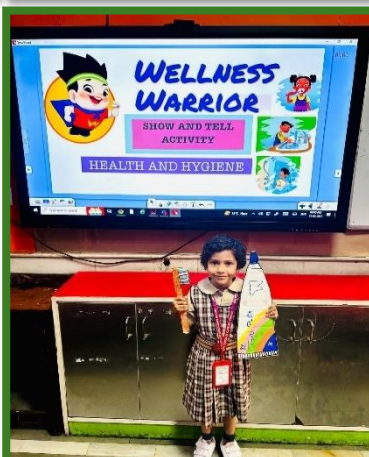
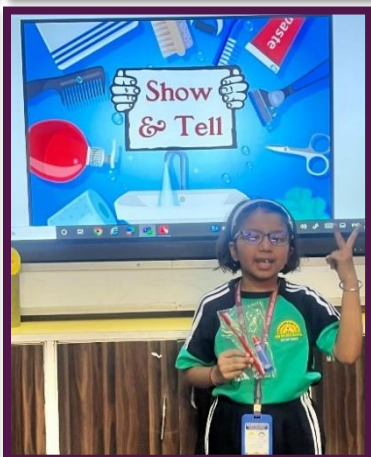
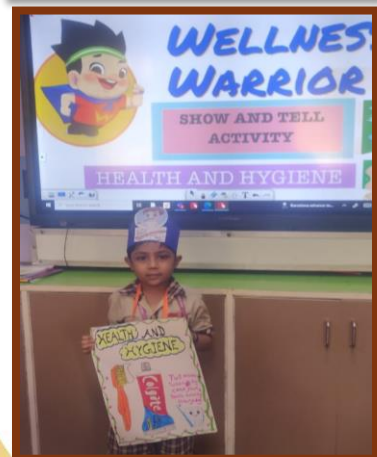
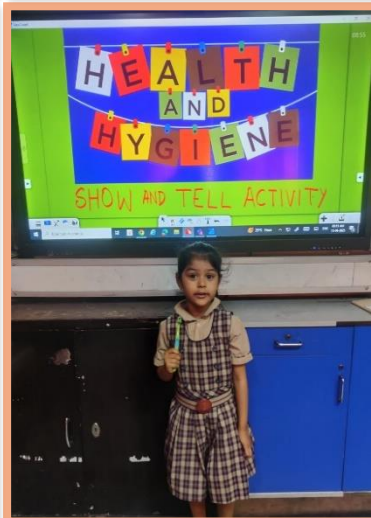
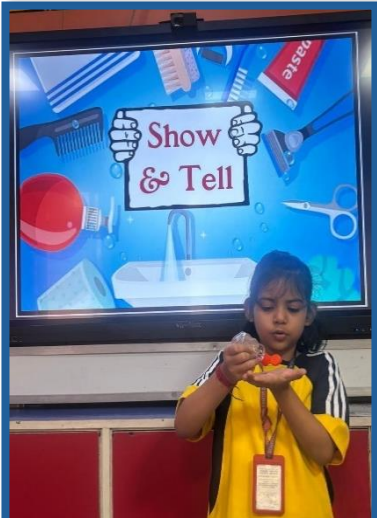


Mother's Day
