Grandparents' Day - A Heartfelt Tribute

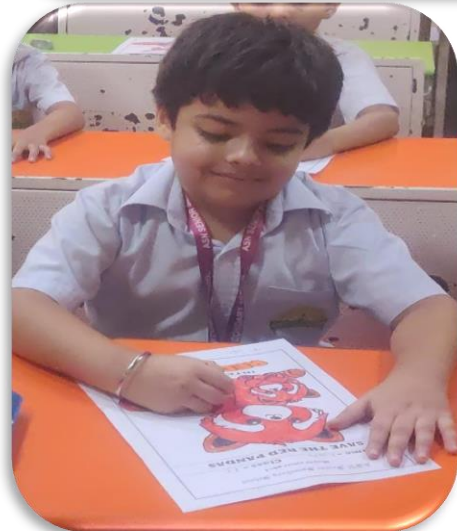

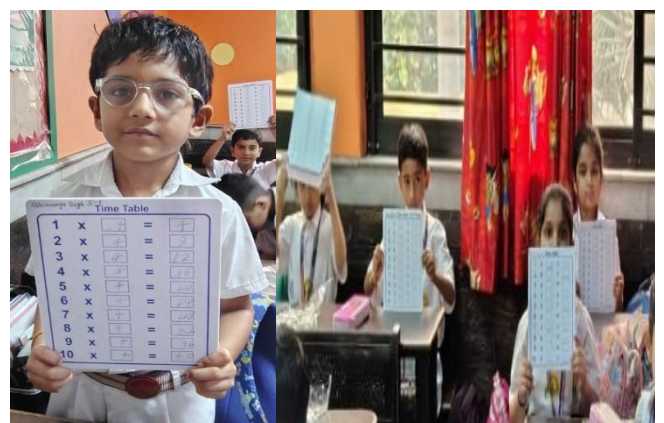

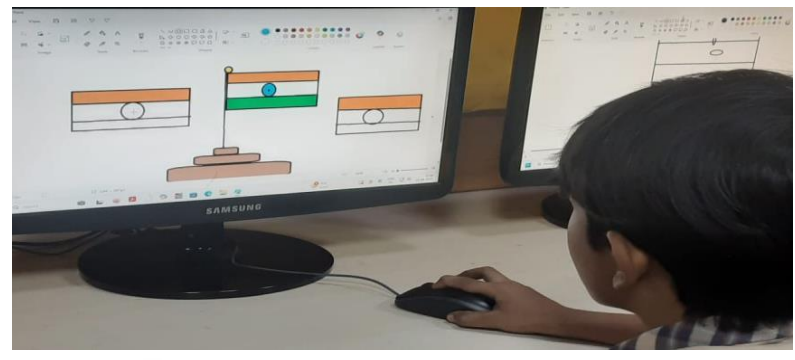
