Here's to another fifty years of extraordinary achievements!

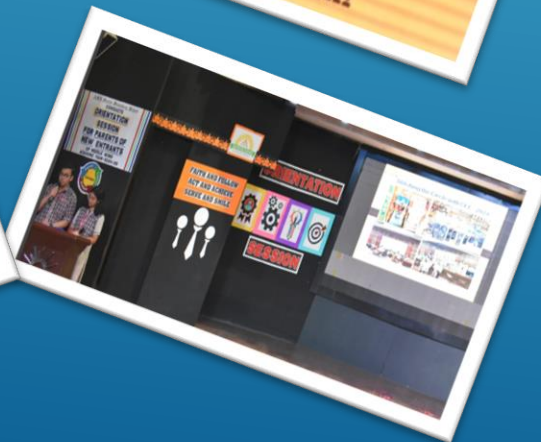
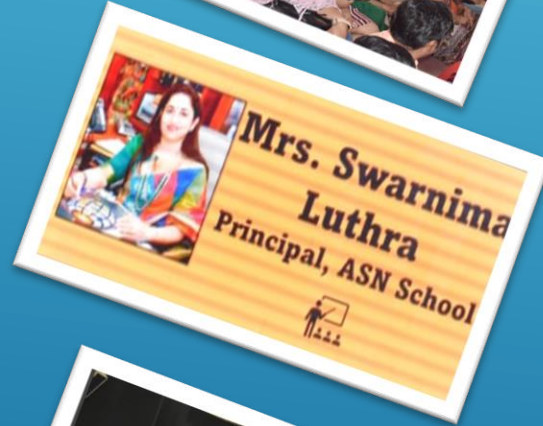
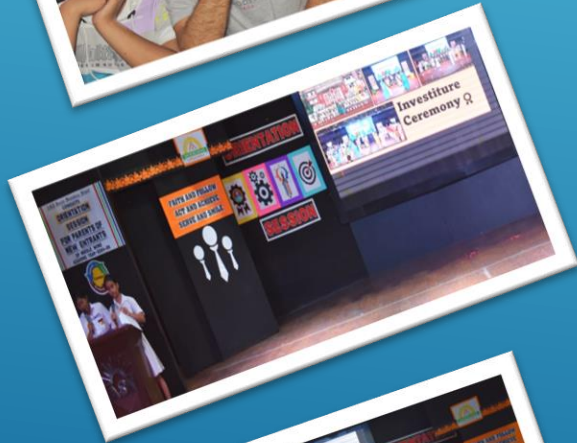

ORIENTATION

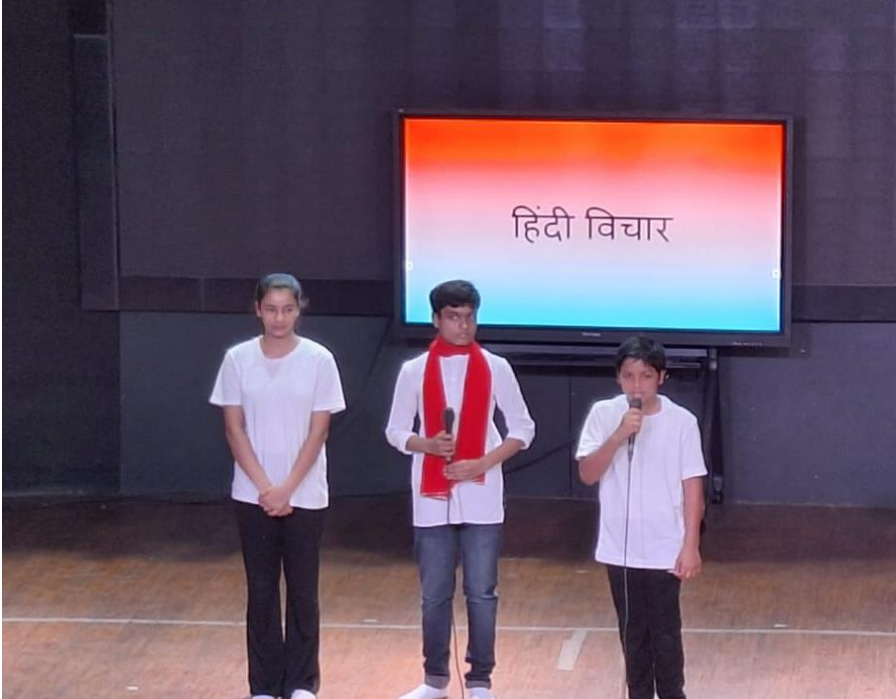

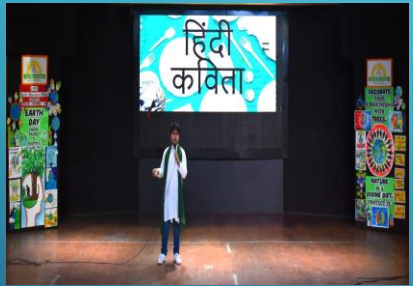
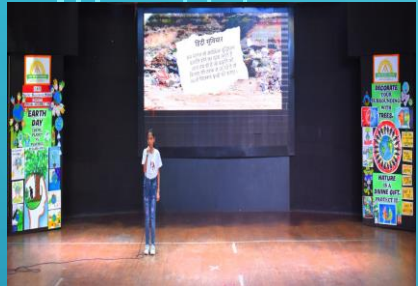


INTERNATIONAL DANCE DAY
