NAVONMESH 2025 | Igniting Innovation, Inspiring Sustainability

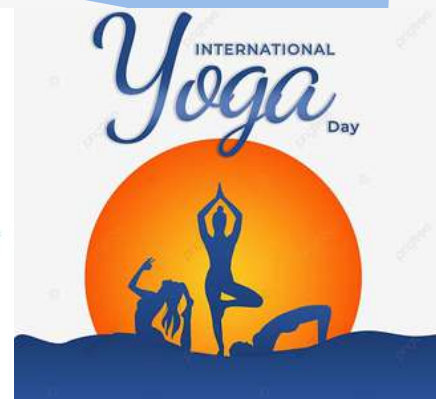

Earth Day Celebration

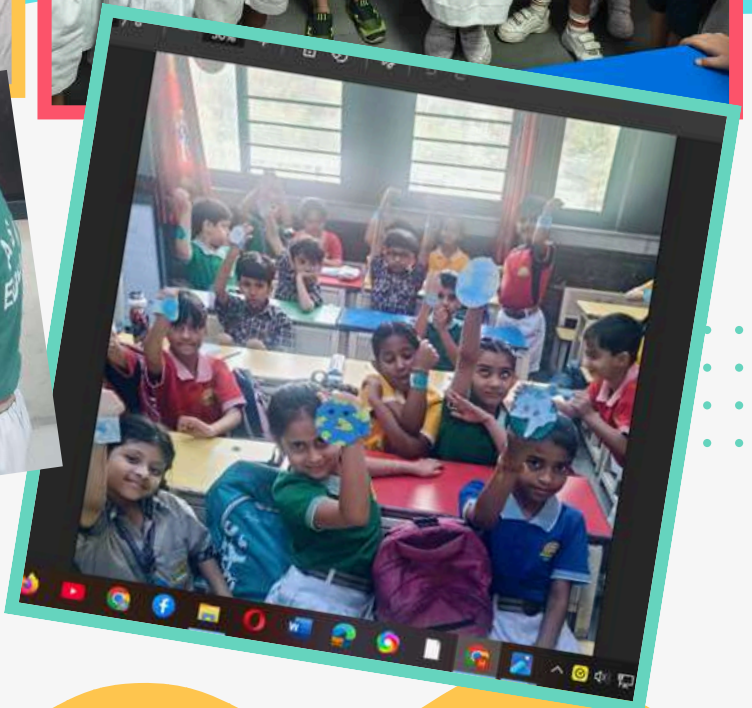
"Earth is our home, and we promise to keep it healthy and beautiful!"

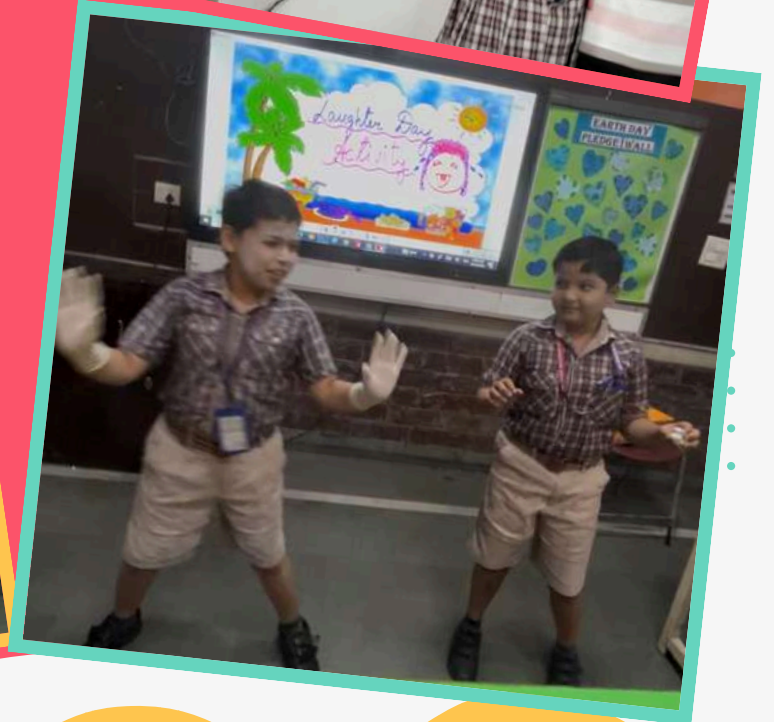
Laughter Day

The Upper Primary Wing of ASN Sr. Sec. School celebrated the Tricolour Creation Craft Activity on 13th August 2025 with creativity and pride!

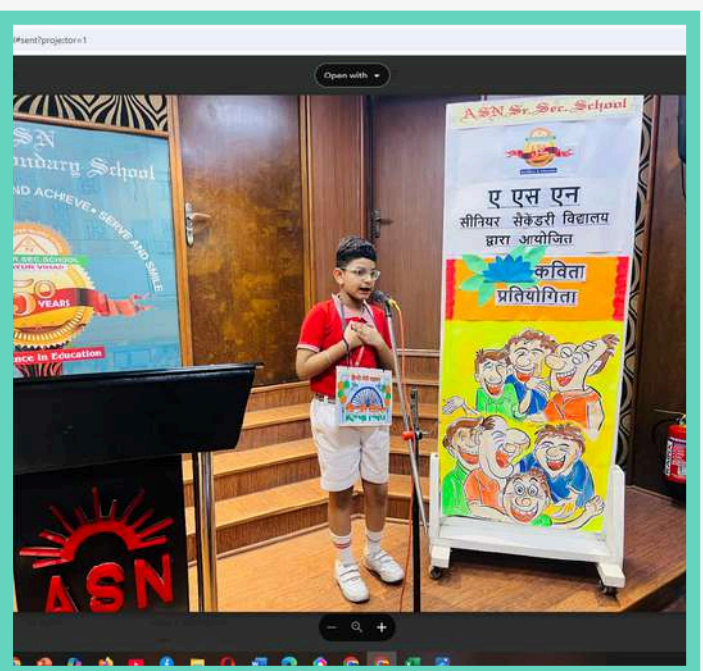
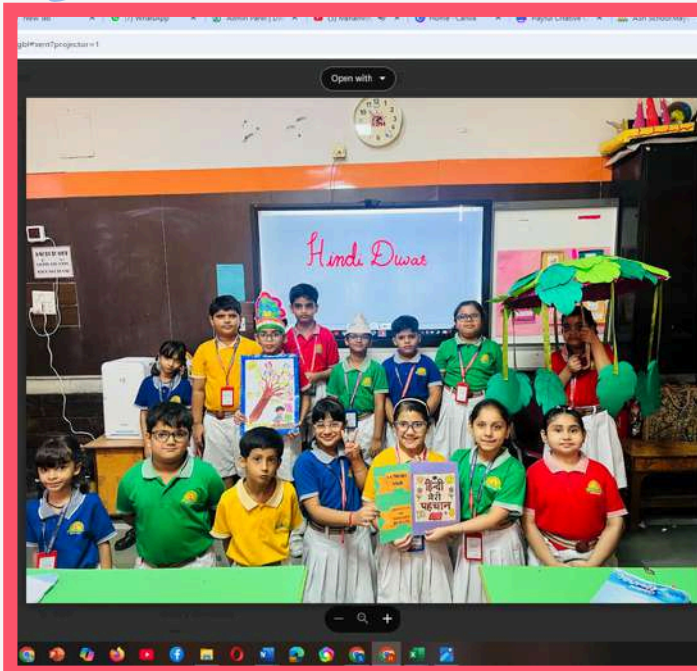
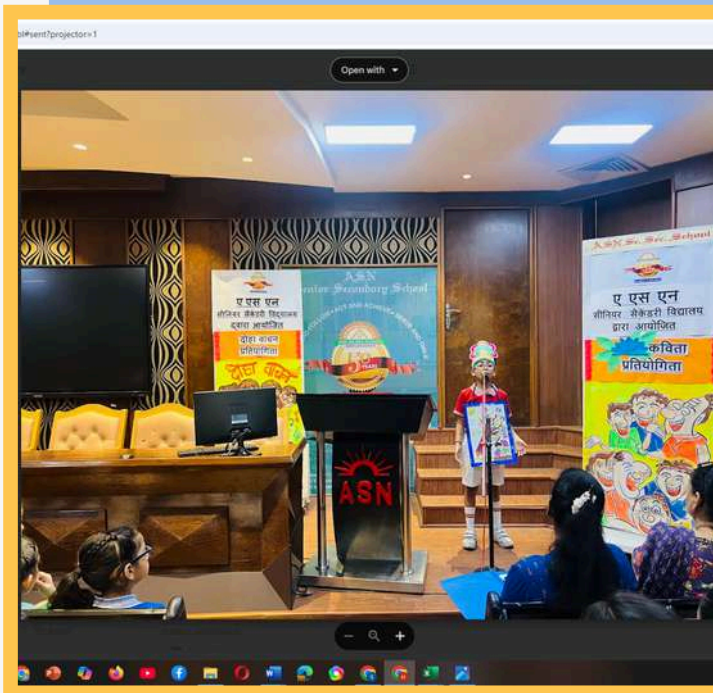
From kites soaring high to flowers blooming with national colours, our young artists filled the school with vibrant of saffron, white, and green colours.

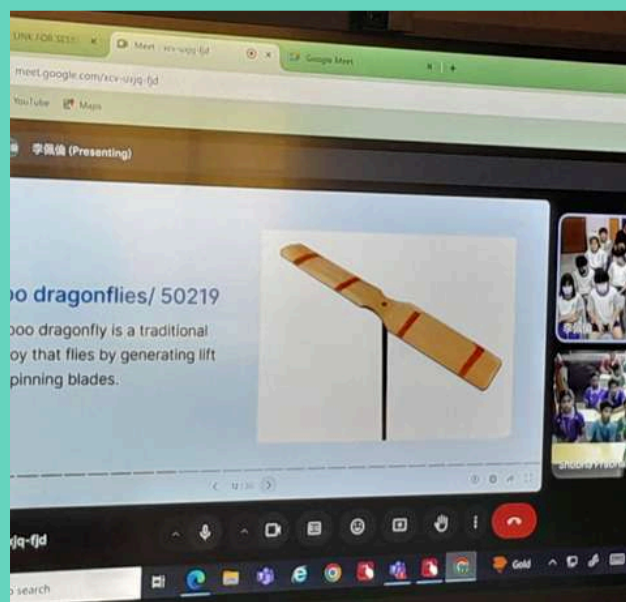
Bridging Cultures, Building Friendships!

'Healing With Herbs'

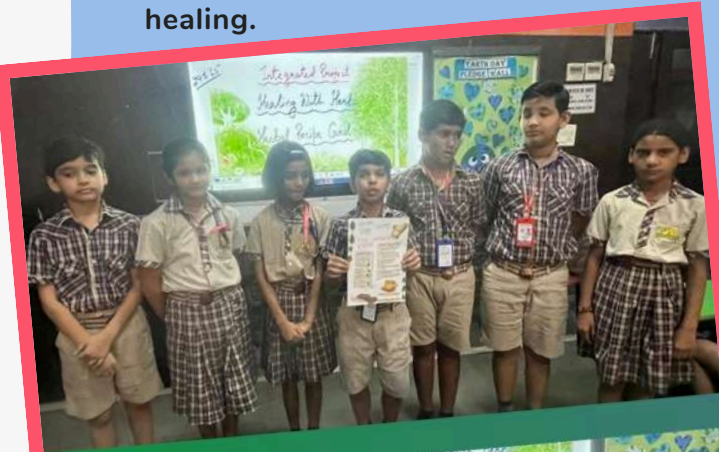
'Nature is the best physician, and herbs are her healing hands'

As part of an interdisciplinary initiative combining Science, Art, and Language, the students of Class V enthusiastically participated in an engaging activity titled 'Healing With Herbs'. This hands-on activity aimed to enhance the students' understanding of the medicinal value of herbs while also fostering creativity and communication skills.

The students explored various commonly available herbs such as tulsi, mint, aloe vera, turmeric, ginger, neem, coriander, etc. and learned about their healing properties. They creatively presented this knowledge by designing 'Herbal Recipe Cards' which included ingredients, preparation methods, usage, and health benefits of simple herbal remedies like 'kadhas', herbal teas and drinks.

The creative and informative recipe cards were created and displayed in the class, and students also presented their recipes to peers, enhancing their confidence and public speaking skills.

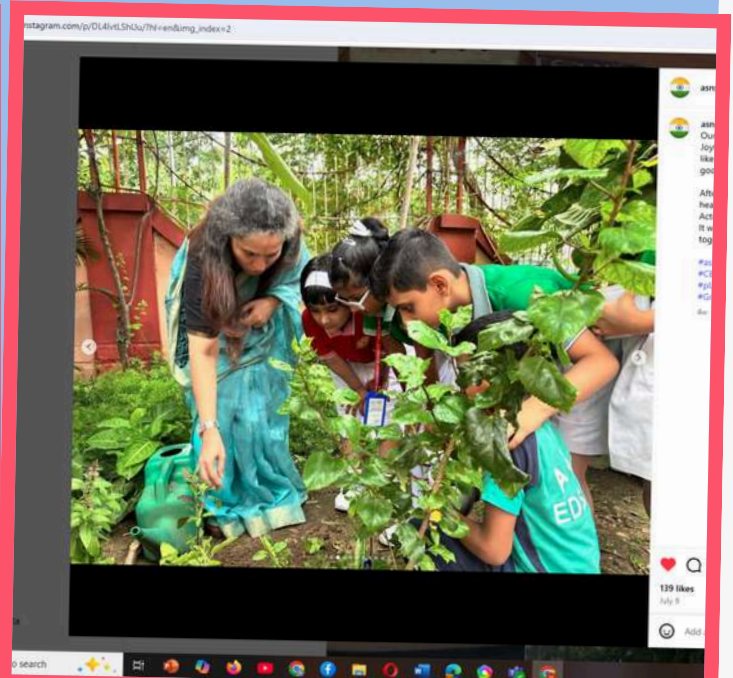
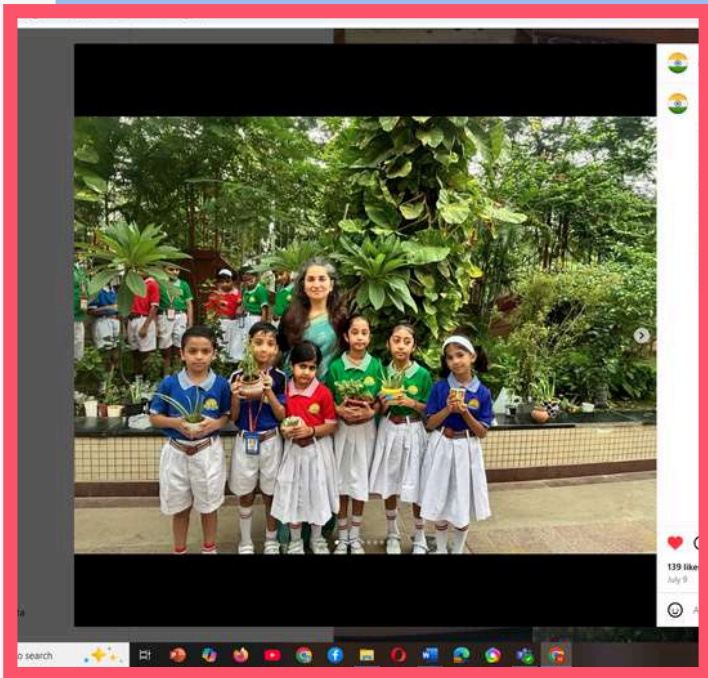
