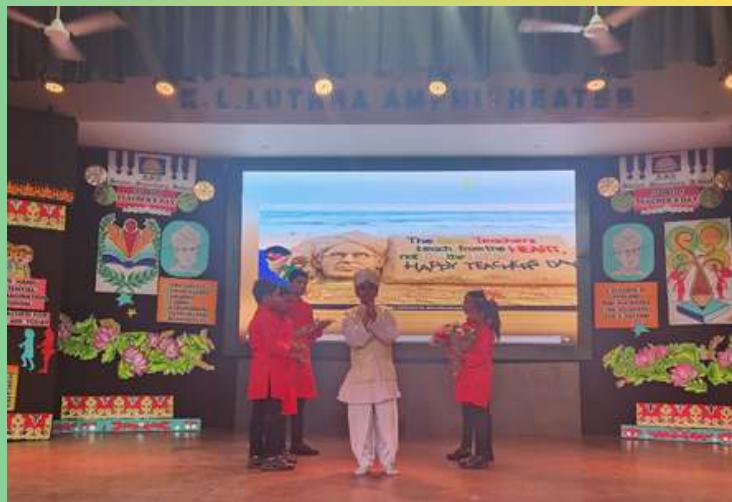
OUR PILLARS, OUR TEACHERS

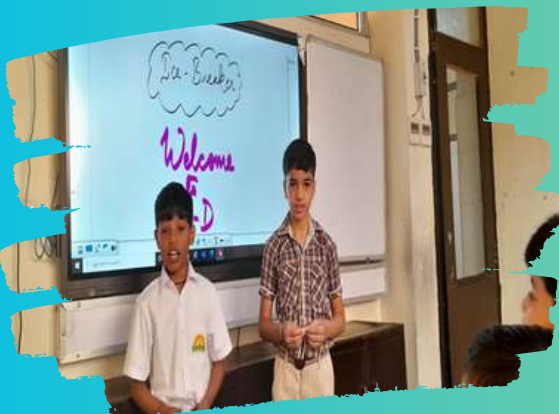
Connecting across Cultures

International Yoga Day Celebration 2023

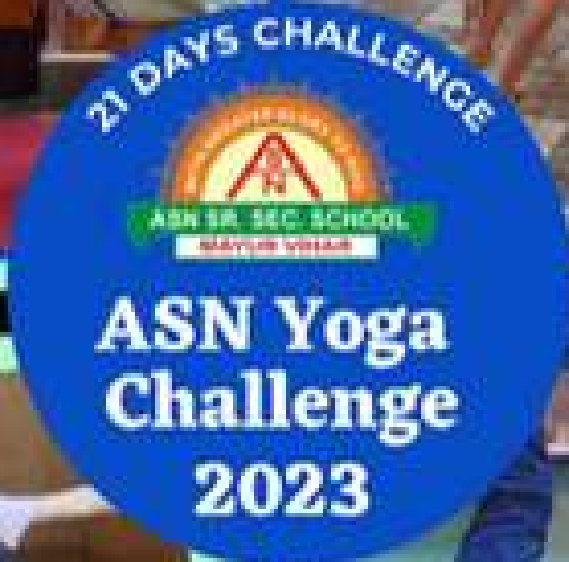
